The Vehicular Traffic (Lighting) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1976

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, hereby order:—

1. The Vehicular Traffic (Lighting) Ordinance, 1963, as amended(a), is hereby amended as follows:— Amendments to Ordinance of 1963.

- (a) in subsection (4) of section two thereof immediately after the words “except when in use as a direction indicator” there are inserted the words “or as a hazard warning pursuant to the provisions of the next succeeding section”;
- (b) immediately after section two thereof there is inserted the following additional section numbered “2A”—

"Use of direction indicators as a hazard warning.

2A. (1) The direction indicators of a vehicle on a public highway may be used as a hazard warning by the simultaneous illumination of the indicators as provided in paragraph (a) of subsection (3) of this section only when operated by means of an appropriate device when the vehicle is stationary and only for the purpose of warning other road users of a temporary obstruction on the carriageway of a public highway.

(2) Any device other than an appropriate device shall not be fitted to a vehicle for the purpose of operating direction indicators by the simultaneous illumination of the indicators as provided in paragraph (a) of the next succeeding subsection.

(3) In this section the expression "appropriate device" means a device which—

(a) is fitted to a vehicle so as to operate simultaneously—

- (i) one or more direction indicators on both sides of the vehicle; or
- (ii) the indicator or indicators as provided in the last preceding subparagraph and one or more direction indicators on both sides of

- any trailer being drawn by the vehicle;
- (b) includes a warning light capable of indicating to the driver of the vehicle when the device is being operated; and
- (c) is actuated by a switch controlling only that device.”.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Vehicular Traffic (Lighting) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1976. Citation.

3. This Ordinance and the Vehicular Traffic (Lighting) Ordinances, 1963 and 1971, may be cited together as the Vehicular Traffic (Lighting) Ordinances, 1963 to 1976. Collective title.
