The Vehicular Traffic (Motor Licences) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1976

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers now vested in them by Article eighteen of the Law entitled "Loi relative aux Automobiles" registered on the eleventh day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty-six^(a), as amended, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the sixth day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, hereby order:—

1. In paragraph (1) of Article nineteen of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance Supplémentaire à l'Ordonnance ayant rapport au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" made permanent on the eighteenth day of January, nineteen hundred and thirty-two, as amended^(b), the full stop at the end thereof is hereby deleted and a colon is substituted therefor and immediately thereafter there is hereby inserted the following proviso—

“Provided that in the case of a motor cycle it shall not be obligatory to exhibit the identification mark on the front of the vehicle; and for the purposes of this proviso the expression “motor cycle” includes a motor cycle combination and an auto-cycle, bicycle or tricycle which is being used as or is adapted for use as a mechanically propelled vehicle.”.

Extent. 2. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Island of Guernsey and in the Island of Alderney.

Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Vehicular Traffic (Motor Licences) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1976.

Collective title. 4. This Ordinance and the Vehicular Traffic (Motor Licences) Ordinances, 1932 to 1970, may be cited together as the Vehicular Traffic (Motor Licences) Ordinances, 1932 to 1976.
