**The Vehicular Traffic (Parking at Beau
Séjour) (Prohibition) Ordinance, 1979**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-sixth day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine, and on the representations of the States Recreation Committee, hereby order:—

1. (1) A person, being in charge of a vehicle, shall not, without permission in writing granted by or on behalf of the States Recreation Committee (hereafter in this section referred to as "the Committee"), park that vehicle within any part of the Beau Séjour Estate in the parish of Saint Peter Port belonging to the States otherwise than in such areas, for such periods, during such hours and subject to such conditions as the Committee may order or direct, from time to time, by means of a traffic sign, that is to say, a signal, warning sign post, direction post, sign or other device erected, placed or marked on or near the carriageway, or other area to which a vehicle may obtain access, by or on behalf of the Committee.

Parking at Beau Séjour prohibited otherwise than in accordance with traffic signs.

(2) Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any order or direction of the Committee given by a traffic sign as aforesaid shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds.

Interpre-
tation.

2. In this Ordinance "vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle and includes a trailer, an animal drawn vehicle, a bicycle and a tricycle.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Vehicular Traffic (Parking at Beau Séjour) (Prohibition) Ordinance, 1979.
