**The Vehicular Traffic (Parking on
St. Peter Port Harbour) (Prohibition)
Ordinance, 1965**

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE, in pursuance of a Resolution of the States of the twenty-fourth day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-four, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by paragraph (3) of Article sixty-six of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and on the representations of the States Board of Administration, hereby order:—

1. A person, being in charge of a vehicle, shall not, without the permission in writing of the States Harbourmaster, park that vehicle on Saint Julian's Pier, Saint Julian's Emplacement, the New Jetty or Parking on North arm of Harbour prohibited.

the White Rock, Saint Peter Port, otherwise than in such areas, for such periods, during such hours and subject to such conditions as the States Board of Administration (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") may order or direct, from time to time, by means of a signal, warning sign post, direction post, sign or other device (hereinafter referred to as "a traffic sign") erected, placed or marked on or near the carriageway by or on behalf of the Board.

Offences.

2. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any order or direction of the Board given by a traffic sign shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, in the case of a first offence to a fine not exceeding ten pounds and in the case of a second or subsequent offence to a fine not exceeding twenty-five pounds.

Interpretation.

3. In this Ordinance the expression "vehicle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle and includes a trailer, an animal drawn vehicle, a bicycle and a tricycle.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Vehicular Traffic (Parking on St. Peter Port Harbour) (Prohibition) Ordinance, 1965.

Commencement.

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the twenty-fourth day of May, nineteen hundred and sixty-five.
