**The Vehicular Traffic (Reporting of  
Accidents) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1969**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-fourth day of September, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, hereby order:—

1. Section (2) of Article XII of the Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile” of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, is hereby repealed and the following is hereby substituted therefor:—

“ (2) If in any case, owing to the presence of a vehicle on a public highway, an accident occurs whereby personal injury is caused to a person other than the driver of that vehicle or damage is caused to a vehicle other than that vehicle or a trailer drawn thereby or to an animal other than an

animal in or on that vehicle or trailer drawn thereby or to property of any other description whatsoever, the driver of the vehicle shall stop immediately and, if required so to do by any person having reasonable grounds for so requiring, give his name and address, and also the name and address of the owner and the identification mark of the vehicle.

(3) If in the case of any such accident as aforesaid the driver of the vehicle for any reason does not give his name and address to any such person as aforesaid, he shall report the accident at the police station or to a member of the Police Force as soon as reasonably practicable, and in any case within twenty-four hours of the occurrence thereof.

(4) Any person who acts in contravention of the provisions of sections (2) or (3) of this Article shall be liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months."
