**The Vehicular Traffic (Traffic Signs and
Light Signals) (Amendment) Ordinance,
1971**

THE STATES, on the representations of the
Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. The Vehicular Traffic (Traffic Signs) Ordinance,
1961(a), is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) in section four thereof the words “five pounds” and “ten pounds” are repealed and the words “ten pounds” and “fifty pounds” are respectively substituted therefor;
- (b) in section five thereof the words “to a fine not exceeding five pounds” are repealed and the words “in the case of a first offence to a fine not exceeding ten pounds and in the case of a second or subsequent offence to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds” are substituted therefor.

2. In subsection (1) of section one of the Vehicular Traffic (Light Signals) Ordinance, 1962(b), the words "five pounds" and "ten pounds" are hereby repealed and the words "ten pounds" and "fifty pounds" are respectively substituted therefor.
