**The Vehicular Traffic Ordinance, 1951.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. Section (6) of Article two of the Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette île, of the second day of March, 1929, as amended by the Ordonnance portant amendement à l'Ordonnance ayant rapport au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette île du 2 mars 1929, of the twentieth day of July, 1934, is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor—

“(6) Wilfully and unlawfully or by negligence or misbehaviour prevent, hinder or interrupt the free passage of any person, vehicle or animal on any public highway.”

2. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 17th day of December, 1951.
