The Royal Court (Election of Counsel) Order, 2002

THE ROYAL COURT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Article 64 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948^a, section 12 of the Royal Court (Miscellaneous Reform Provisions) Law, 1950^b and section 25 of the Magistrate's Court (Guernsey) Law, 1954^c, and in exercise of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Choice of counsel no longer to be made before Royal Court.

1. Where a person, whether or not in custody, is charged with an offence for which he is to be tried before the Royal Court -

- (a) he shall not, after the date of commencement of this Order, be required to appear before the Royal Court to choose counsel; and
- (b) his choice of counsel need not, after that date, be tabled before, and recorded by, the Royal Court.

Repeal.

2. The Royal Court (Election of Counsel) Order, 1994^d is repealed.
