**The Export Control (Miscellaneous Goods) (Bailiwick of
Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 2012**

THE HOME DEPARTMENT in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 1 and 7 of the Export Control (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2006^a and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

Amendment to Order of 2010.

1. Schedule 4 to the Export Control (Miscellaneous Goods) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 2010^b is amended by inserting, immediately after paragraph 4, the following paragraph –

- "5. (a) 2-(ethylamino)-2-(3-methoxyphenyl)cyclohexanone,
- (b) any stereoisomeric form of 2-(ethylamino)-2-(3-methoxyphenyl)cyclohexanone,

- (c) any salt of a substance specified in subparagraph (a) or (b), or
- (d) any preparation or other product containing a substance specified in any of subparagraphs (a) to (c)."

Interpretation.

2. (1) In this Order, a reference to any enactment is a reference to the enactment as from time to time amended, varied, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

(2) The provisions of the Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c apply to the interpretation of this Order as they apply to the interpretation of an enactment in force in the Island of Guernsey.

Citation and commencement.

3. This Order may be cited as the Export Control (Miscellaneous Goods) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 2012, and comes into force on the 1st June, 2012.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order adds 2-(ethylamino)-2-(3-methoxyphenyl)cyclohexanone and related substances, commonly known as methoxetamine, to the list of prohibited exports in Schedule 4 to the Export Control (Miscellaneous Goods) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 2010.

This Order comes into force on the 1st June, 2012.
