**The Offences (Fixed Penalties) (Guernsey)
Order, 2012**

THE HOME DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 5(1)(b) of the Offences (Fixed Penalties) (Guernsey) Law, 2009^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Manner and place of fixed penalty payment.

1. (1) A fixed penalty must be paid –
 - (a) in cash,
 - (b) by postal order or by cheque made payable to the 'States of Guernsey', or
 - (c) by debit or credit card.

- (2) Payment must be –

- (a) delivered in person at, or sent by post (which in the case of a payment by cash, means by registered post, recorded post or special delivery) to, the Chief Accountant, Sir Charles Frossard House, La Charroterie, St Peter Port, Guernsey, GY1 1FH,
- (b) delivered in person to any Guernsey Post Office, or
- (c) made over the telephone by debit or credit card by telephoning the Cashiers at Sir Charles Frossard House.

Revocation.

2. The Fixed Penalties (No.2) Order, 1992^b is hereby revoked.

Interpretation.

3. (1) In this Order "fixed penalty" means a fixed penalty whose payment in accordance with the Offences (Fixed Penalties) (Guernsey) Law, 2009 discharges any liability to conviction of an offence particularised in a fixed penalty notice issued under section 2 of that Law.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the interpretation of this Order.

(3) Any reference in this Order to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.


