

**GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT 2012 No. 29**

**The Control of Intoxicating Liquor (Designated Public Places)  
(Guernsey Festival) Order 2012**

Made: 18<sup>th</sup> June 2012

Coming into force: 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2012


THE STATES HOME DEPARTMENT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 2(1) and (2) of the Control of Intoxicating Liquor (Designated Public Places) Ordinance, 2007, hereby orders:-

1. In order to prevent nuisance or annoyance to members of the public or a section of the public or disorder which is likely to be associated with the consumption of intoxicating liquor in that place, the area marked in red on the attached plan, that is:-
  - (a) Les Banques, St Peter Port/St Sampsons (from outside the Red Lion Pub as far as the Halfway filter with the junction of Vale Road and Les Bas Courtils), the area to include the whole of the road and grassed verges to the east, up to and including the sea wall.
  - (b) The entire length of Victoria Avenue, St Sampsons, as far west as the Bowl.


shall be a designated public place for the purpose of the Ordinance between 12:00 noon on Saturday 23 June and 8.00am on Monday 25 June 2012

2. This Order may be cited as the Intoxicating Liquor (Designated Public Places) (Guernsey Live Event) Order 2012.
3. This Order shall come into force on the 23 June 2012.
