

The Immigration (Control on Entry) (E.E.C. and Other Non-Commonwealth Nationals) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Rules, 1973

Made	27 December, 1973
Laid before the States	1974
Coming into Operation	1 January 1974

The STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (2) of section three of the Immigration Act 1971, as extended to the Bailiwick by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 1972, hereby makes the following Rules:-

Amendments to Rules of 1973

1. The Immigration (Control on Entry) (E.E.C. and Other Non-Commonwealth Nationals) (Guernsey) Rules, 1973 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Rules") are hereby amended as follows:-

- (a) in paragraph 8 thereof the words "Nationals of countries listed in the Appendix" are hereby repealed and the words "The foreign nationals specified in the Appendix" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (b) in the second sentence of paragraph 8 thereof the words "for the issue of a letter of consent" are hereby repealed and the words "for the issue of a visa or a letter of consent issued" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (c) the Appendix thereto is hereby repealed and the Appendix set out in the Appendix to these Rules is hereby substituted therefor.

Entry clearances for citizens of Pakistan

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the principal Rules, a citizen of Pakistan seeking admission to the Bailiwick as the wife, child or other dependant of a person settled in the Bailiwick (or of a person admitted for employment, or as a businessman, a person of independent means or a self-employed person) or as the husband

or fiancé of such a person, shall produce a United Kingdom visa; and for citizens of Pakistan who seek admission for other purposes, and who wish to ascertain in advance whether they are eligible for admission, the entry clearance for which they may apply shall take the form of a visa.

Citation

3. These Rules may be cited as the Immigration (Control on Entry) (E.E.C. and Other Non-Commonwealth Nationals) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Rules, 1973.

Commencement

4. These Rules shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-four.

FOREIGN COUNTRIES WHOSE NATIONALS NEED VISAS FOR THE UNITED KINGDOM, CHANNEL ISLANDS AND ISLE OF MAN

EUROPE

Nationals of Albania	Hungary
Bulgaria	Poland
Czechoslovakia	Romania
German Democratic Republic	U.S.S.R.

ASIA

Nationals of Pakistan who seek admission to the Bailiwick in accordance with paragraph 9 of these Rules and nationals of all other countries except Bahrain, Iran, Israel, Japan, Kuwait, Maldivé Islands, Republic of Korea, Qatar and Turkey.

AFRICA

Nationals of all countries except Algeria, Ivory Coast, Morocco, Tunisia and the Republic of South Africa.

AMERICA

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Rules amend the Immigration (Control on Entry) (E.E.C. and Other Non-Commonwealth Nationals) (Guernsey) Rules, 1973, so as to make provision for a visa abolition agreement concluded between Her Majesty's Government and the Imperial Government of Iran and for the imposition of a visa requirement upon certain citizens of Pakistan.
