THE IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946
THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1971
AMENDMENT TO OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1971, dated the 16th March, 1971, (a), the importation into Guernsey of goods consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the States Board of Administration:

NOW THEREFORE the States Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises as follows:-

1. The Open General Import Licence made by the States Board of Administration and dated the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy one, (b), as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:-
 - (a) In Article 1 relating to "Areas" the following definitions shall be added:-
 - " (i) "Non-Community Area" means all countries and territories other than Belgium, Denmark, France, the Federal Republic of Germany and Berlin (West), Italy, the Republic of Ireland, Luxembourg, the Netherlands and the United Kingdom;
 - (ii) "Non CEFTA Area" means all countries and territories other than Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, the Federal Republic of Germany and Berlin (West), Iceland, the Republic of Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Switzerland and the United Kingdom."
 - (b) In Article 3 after paragraph (vi) the following paragraphs shall be added:-
 - " (vii) goods originating in or consigned to Guernsey from the Non-Community Area and comprised in an entry in that Schedule in relation to which the letters 'NC' so appear;
 - (viii) goods originating in or consigned to Guernsey from the Non CEFTA Area and comprised in an entry in that Schedule in relation to which the letters 'NCEFTA' so appear."
 - (c) In Article 4 sub-paragraph (a) shall be deleted and the following sub-paragraph (a) substituted therefor:-
 - " (a) if they originate in Australia, Austria, Belgium, Canada, Denmark, Finland, France, the Federal Republic of Germany or Berlin (West), Iceland, Israel, Italy, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Sweden, Switzerland or the United States of America and are consigned to Guernsey from any of those countries or sectors; or "
 - (d) the First Schedule thereto is hereby deleted and the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Amendment is hereby substituted therefor.
2. This Amendment shall take effect on the twenty second day of February nineteen hundred and seventy three and may be modified or revoked at any time by the States Board of Administration.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Amendment to the Open General Import Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The main effects of this Amendment are as follows:-

1. To be imported under the authority of the Open General Import Licence domestic pottery originating in and consigned from Japan has hitherto required either an authorisation by the Government of Japan or certification by the Japanese Pottery Design Center as being of traditional Japanese design. This amendment revokes these requirements.
2. It allows the import under the Licence of certain cotton textiles from Israel and certain grapefruit unless it is consigned from the Non Community Area. It also allows the import under the Licence of certain jute goods unless they originate in or are consigned from the Non CEFTA Area. Certain oils and chemicals, enamelled hollow-ware, certain clocks and clock components, and Christmas tree decorations of glass may now be imported under the Licence notwithstanding that they originate in or are consigned from the Eastern Area. Similarly, aluminium powder and flakes may now be imported from Romania. It allows, too, the import under the Licence of benzole, paraffin wax and hydrocarbons notwithstanding that they originate in or are consigned from the Eastern Area other than Romania.
3. Certain agricultural and horticultural products may now be imported from various sources under the authority of the Licence.

- E Watches of a value not exceeding £1.50 each cif (not including the value of any strap, bracelet or similar attachment) other than stop-watches not capable of indicating the time of day.
- E Watch movements of a value not exceeding £1.25 each cif.

W Firearms and ammunition, the following:-

- (i) firearms, lethal, including any lethal barreled weapon of any description from which any shot, bullet or other missile can be discharged and other weapons of whatever description designed or adapted for the discharge of any noxious liquid, gas or other thing;
- (ii) component parts (other than wooden gun stocks) of any such firearms or other weapon as afore-said and any accessory to any such firearm or other weapon designed or adapted to diminish the noise or flash caused by firing the weapon;
- (iii) ammunition, including grenades, bombs, and other like missiles, and any ammunition containing or designed or adapted to contain any noxious liquid, gas or other thing and component parts of any such ammunition;

other than the following;

- (a) cartridges for smooth-bore guns, being cartridges containing five or more shots none of which exceeds 0.36 in. in diameter;
- (b) blank cartridges not exceeding 1 in. in diameter for use in smooth-bore weapons;
- (c) air guns, air rifles or air pistols incapable of discharging a missile so that the missile has, on being discharged from the muzzle of the weapon, kinetic energy in excess, in the case of an air pistol, of 6 ft. lb or, in the case of an air weapon other than an air pistol, of 12 ft. lb. and air weapons designed for use only under water;
- (d) ammunition for air guns, air rifles or air pistols;
- (e) articles more than one hundred years old.
