THE SOCIAL INSURANCE (CLAIMS AND PAYMENTS) (AMENDMENT)  
(GUERNSEY) REGULATIONS, 1973

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section forty-four and section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of regulation ten of the principal regulations.

1. In paragraph (1) of regulation ten of the Social Insurance (Claims and Payments) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations"), the words "six months", wherever they occur, are hereby repealed and the words "twelve months" are hereby substituted therefor.

Amendment of regulation sixteen of the principal regulations.

2. In the proviso to paragraph (3) of regulation sixteen of the principal regulations, the words "six months" are hereby repealed and the words "twelve months" are hereby substituted therefor.

Amendment of Part II of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations.

3. In paragraph 2 of Part II of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations, the words "six months" are hereby repealed and the words "twelve months" are hereby substituted therefor.

Transitional provisions.

4. (1) The provisions of paragraph 2 of Part II of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations in force immediately before the date of the coming into operation of these regulations shall continue to apply to any sum on account of any benefit to which those provisions apply in respect of a period more than six months before that date.

(2) The provisions of regulation ten and regulation sixteen of the principal regulations, as amended by these regulations, shall apply to any right to a sum by way of benefit accruing before the coming into operation of these regulations.

Citation, collective title and commencement.

5. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Claims and Payments) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1973.

(2) These regulations, the Social Insurance (Claims and Payments) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, and the Social Insurance (Claims and Payments) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Claims and Payments) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971 to 1973.

(3) These regulations shall come into operation on the twenty-sixth day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-three.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations amend the provisions of the Social Insurance (Claims and Payments) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, so as to extend from six months to twelve months the time within which payment of an award once made must be obtained, and so as to also extend from six months to twelve months the maximum period for which benefit may be paid for late claims. The remaining provisions are of a consequential or a transitional nature.
