

The Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Bailiwick
of Guernsey) Order 1973

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by sections seven and fifteen of the Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1972, hereby orders:-

1. The areas specified in the First Schedule to this Order are hereby appointed and named as ports for the purposes of customs and excise.

2. The aerodromes specified in the Second Schedule to this Order are hereby appointed as customs airports for the purposes of customs and excise.

3. The provisions of subsection (1) of section fifteen of the Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1972 shall not apply to the following classes of goods:-

- (a) ~~goods which are shipped directly to the Island from, and have previously been landed in, the Island of Jersey or another Island of this Bailiwick;~~
- (b) goods imported from the United Kingdom which -
 - (i) are of United Kingdom growth, origin or manufacture; or
 - (ii) are not of United Kingdom origin and -
 - (aa) have been imported into the United Kingdom free of customs duties by virtue of preferential trade arrangements currently in force; or
 - (bb) have borne customs duties in the United Kingdom, are not in the same state as when originally imported, and have not benefited from any relief from duty on re-exportation;

goods brought by post into the Bailiwick unless the Chief Revenue Officer sends to the addressee of the packet in which they are contained or to any other person who is for the time being the importer of the goods a notice requiring entry to be made.

4. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

5. This Order may be cited as The Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1973.

6. This Order shall come into force on the first day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-three.
