THE SOCIAL INSURANCE (GENERAL BENEFIT) (AMENDMENT) (GUERNSEY)  
REGULATIONS, 1973

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section thirty-seven and section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of regulation ten of the principal regulations.

1. In paragraph (2) of regulation ten of the Social Insurance (General Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations"), the words "six months" are hereby repealed and the words "twelve months" are hereby substituted therefor.

Transitional provisions.

2. The provisions of paragraph (2) of regulation ten of the principal regulations, as amended by these regulations, shall apply to any right to a sum by way of benefit accruing before the coming into operation of these regulations.

Citation, collective title and commencement.

3. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (General Benefit) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1973.

(2) These regulations, the principal regulations and the Social Insurance (General Benefit) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (General Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 to 1973.

(3) These regulations shall come into force on the Twenty-sixth day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy-three.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These Regulations are made in consequence of the Social Insurance (Claims and Payments) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1973, and amend the provisions of the Social Insurance (General Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, relating to the disregard

of any period of suspension of the payment of benefit by reason of imprisonment in calculating the period after which, if payment has not been obtained, the right to benefit is extinguished under the Law.
