

OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1971, dated the 16th March, 1971, (a), the importation into Guernsey of goods consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the States Board of Administration.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby revokes the Open General Import Licence dated the 30th day of November, 1971 and the Amendments thereto, and grants the following Open General Import Licence:-

Interpretation

1. (1) For the purposes of this Licence:-

Areas

"Dollar Area" means Bolivia, Canada, Columbia, Costa Rica, Cuba, the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guatemala, Haiti, the Republic of Honduras, Liberia, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, the Phillipines, the United States of America and Venezuela;

"Eastern Area" means Albania, Bulgaria, Czechoslovakia, the German Democratic Republic and Berlin (East), Hungary, North Korea, North Vietnam, the People's Republic of China, the People's Republic of Mongolia, Poland, Romania and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics;

"GATT Area" means the countries for the time being listed in Annex II of Regulation (EEC) No. 1025/70;

"Mediterranean Area" means Cyprus, Greece, Lebanon, Malta, Morocco, Spain, Tunisia and Turkey;

"Non Community Area" means all countries and territories other than Belgium, Denmark, France, the Federal Republic of Germany and Berlin (West), the Republic of Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands and the United Kingdom; and

"Non CEFTA Area" means all countries and territories other than Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, the Federal Republic of Germany and Berlin (West), Iceland, the Republic of Ireland, Italy, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Switzerland and the United Kingdom.

(2) Numerical references in the Schedules hereto are to headings of the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (No. 61) Order, 1973 (b) and, accordingly:-

(a) where any such reference is preceded by the word 'ex' the relevant entry shall be taken to comprise all goods which would be classified under an entry in the same terms constituting a sub-heading in the relevant heading; and

(b) all other entries shall be taken to comprise all goods which are classified in the heading mentioned at the beginning of the entry.

2. Subject to Article 6 hereof, goods not comprised in any entry in any of the Schedules hereto may be imported into Guernsey under the authority of this Licence.
3. Subject to Article 6 hereof, goods comprised in any entry in Schedule 1 hereto may be imported into Guernsey under the authority of this Licence unless they are:-

- (i) goods comprised in an entry in relation to which the letter 'W' appears in the second column of that Schedule;
- (ii) goods originating in, or consigned to Guernsey from, the Dollar Area and comprised in an entry in that Schedule in relation to which the letter 'D' so appears;
- (iii) goods originating in, or consigned to Guernsey from, the Eastern Area and comprised in an entry in that Schedule in relation to which the letter 'E' so appears;
- (iv) goods originating in the GATT Area and comprised in an entry in that Schedule in relation to which the letter 'G' so appears;
- (v) goods originating in Japan and consigned to Guernsey otherwise than from Japan or goods consigned from Japan but otherwise than under the authority of the Government of Japan, and (in either case) comprised in an entry in that Schedule in relation to which the letter 'J' so appears;
- (vi) goods originating in, or consigned to Guernsey from, the Non Community Area and comprised in an entry in that Schedule in relation to which the letters 'NC' so appear;
- (vii) goods originating in, or consigned to Guernsey from, the Non CEEFTA Area and comprised in an entry in that Schedule in relation to which the letters 'NCEFTA' so appear;
- (viii) goods originating in, or consigned to Guernsey from, Romania and comprised in an entry in that Schedule in relation to which the letters 'RO' so appear;
- (ix) goods originating in Yugoslavia and comprised in an entry in that Schedule in relation to which the letter 'Y' so appears:

PROVIDED that nothing in this Article shall operate to authorise the importation of any goods if the goods are comprised in an entry in Schedule 1 and also in an entry in Schedules 2 or 3 hereto.

4. Subject to Article 6 hereof, goods comprised in any entry in Schedule 2 hereto may be imported into Guernsey under the authority of this Licence:-
- (a) if they originate in Australia, Austria, Belgium, Canada, Denmark, Finland, France, the Federal Republic of Germany or Berlin (West), Iceland, the Republic of Ireland, Israel, Italy, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Switzerland or the United States of America and are consigned to Guernsey from any of those countries or territories; or
 - (b) if they originate in Japan and are consigned to Guernsey from Japan and are not goods which are also comprised in an entry in Schedule 1 in relation to which the letter 'J' appears in the second column of that Schedule; or

- (c) if they are cotton yarn within the headings 55.05 or 55.06 of the Import Duties Order 1973 and originate in and are consigned to Guernsey from the Mediterranean Area; or
 - (d) if they are handloom fabrics, or articles made entirely or mainly of handloom fabrics, and a certificate in respect thereof by the Department of Trade and Industry under the provisions of Article 3 (1)(b) of the United Kingdom Import Duty Reliefs (No. 1) Order, 1972 is produced to the Chief Revenue Officer.
5. Subject to Articles 3 and 6 hereof, goods comprised in any entry in Schedule 3 hereto may be imported into Guernsey under the authority of this Licence if they originate in the following Area or in any of the following countries or territories:-
- (a) the Eastern Area; or
 - (b) the countries or territories set out in Article 4(a); or
 - (c) Japan
- and are consigned to Guernsey from that Area or from any of those countries or territories.

Exceptions, etc.

6. (1) Nothing in this Licence shall authorise the importation:-

- (i) of any goods which have been exported from Southern Rhodesia other than goods which have only passed through Southern Rhodesia in transit and have not been the subject of any transaction there other than a transaction relating solely to their transportation; or
- (ii) of ferro-chromium that has been manufactured or processed from, or partly from, or contains, goods exported from Southern Rhodesia in contravention of any order made under the Southern Rhodesia Act 1965; or
- (iii) of plumage or articles consisting wholly or partly of plumage (whether within heading 05.07 or 67.01 or any other heading of the Import Duties Order 1973) except where a written declaration is delivered to the Chief Revenue Officer containing a statement specifying the descriptions of birds from which the plumage was obtained and the plumage or the plumage content is plumage only of birds ordinarily used in Guernsey as articles of diet or birds of one or more of the following species:-

- African ostrich
- Eider duck
- Rhea rothschildi - order rheiformes
- Common jay (garrulus glandarius) - order passeriformes
- Common magpie (pica pica) - order passeriformes
- Common starling (sturnus vulgaris) - order passeriformes
- Java sparrow (munia oryzivora) - order passeriformes
- West African ring-necked parrakeet (palaeornis docilis) - order psittaciformes
- Chinese bustard (otis tarda dybowskyi) - order charadriiformes
- Golden Pheasant (crysolophus pictus) - order galliformes
- Common cormorant (phalacrocorax carbo) - order steganopodes;
- Common shag (phalacrocorax aristotelis) - order steganopodes:

(iv) of raw, tanned or dressed furskins (other than tanned or dressed furskins assembled in plates, crosses and similar forms), or of rugs or coverlets made from furskins (within the headings 43.01, 43.02 or 43.03 of the Import Duties Order 1973) except where:-

- (a) a written declaration is delivered to the Chief Revenue Officer containing a statement specifying the description of animals from which the furskins were obtained, and
- (b) the furskins were obtained from animals other than animal of the following descriptions:-

Clouded leopard (neofelis nubulosa)
Snow leopard (uncia uncia)
Leopard (panthera pardus)
Tiger (panthera tigris)
Cheetah (Acinonyx jubatus)
Vicuna (vicugna vicugna); or

(v) of whale products (other than sperm oil) within the headings 02.04, 02.06, 05.09, 05.15, 15.04, 15.08, 15.12 or 16.03 of the Import Duties Order 1973.

(2) In this Article, 'plumage' includes skins or other parts of birds with feathers.

This Licence shall come into operation on the twentieth day of August, nineteen hundred and seventy-three

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Licence replaces the Open General Import Licence granted by the Board of Administration on the 30th November, 1971, and the amendments thereto.

The form of the new Licence differs considerably from that of the previous one and there are also some changes in licensing arrangements.

Subject to certain overriding exceptions set out in Article 6 relating to Southern Rhodesia, plumage, furskins and whale products, all goods which are not included in any of the three Schedules may be imported under the authority of this Licence.

Goods comprised in Schedule 1 may be imported under the licence except in certain cases when an individual import licence will be required. The following series of key letters is employed to indicate such exceptions:-

- 'W' indicates goods which may not in any circumstances be imported under the Licence;
- 'D' indicates goods which may not be imported under the Licence if they originate in or are consigned from the Dollar Area (defined in Article 1);
- 'E' indicates goods which may not be imported under the Licence if they originate in or are consigned from the Eastern Area (defined in Article 1);
- 'G' indicates goods which may not be imported under the Licence if they originate in the GATT Area (defined in Article 1);
- 'J' indicates goods which may not be imported under the Licence if they originate in Japan unless they are consigned from Japan under the authority of the Japanese government;
- 'NC' indicates goods which may not be imported under the Licence if they originate in or are consigned from the Non Community Area (defined in Article 1);
- 'NCEFTA' indicates goods which may not be imported under the Licence if they originate in or are consigned from the Non CEFTA Area (defined in Article 1);
- 'RO' indicates goods which may not be imported under the Licence if they originate in or are consigned from Romania;
- 'Y' indicates goods which may not be imported under the Licence if they originate in Yugoslavia.

Goods comprised in Schedule 2 (cotton textiles) may be imported under the Licence only in the four cases mentioned in Article 4 of the Licence.

Goods comprised in Schedule 3 (polyester cotton textiles) may be imported under the Licence only in the three cases mentioned in Article 5 of the Licence.

The overriding exceptions set out in Article 6 also apply in relation to goods mentioned in the Schedules and the provisions allowing the import of goods mentioned in Schedule 1 do not extend to permitting the import of goods which are also mentioned in Schedules 2 or 3.

The Licence does not relieve importers from compliance with any other restrictions to which the goods may be subject, including restrictions on, or the prohibition of, imports by any enactment other than Orders made under Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946.
