The Social Insurance (Classification) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1973

Made *5th September* 1973
Laid before the States 1973
Coming into operation *10th September* 1973

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section one and section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of First Schedule to the principal regulations.

1. The First Schedule to the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, as amended, is hereby further amended, as follows, that is to say:-

- (a) in paragraph 8 of column (B) of Part II thereof, the words "Postmaster-General" are hereby repealed and the words "States Post Office Board" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (b) in paragraph 15 of column (A) of Part III thereof, the words "forty shillings" are hereby repealed and the words "five pounds" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (c) in paragraphs 28 to 33 of column (B) of Part III thereof, the words "forty shillings" are hereby repealed and the words "five pounds" are hereby substituted therefor.

Citation and commencement.

2. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Classification) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1973 and these regulations and the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1966, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 to 1973.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the *tenth* day of *September* nineteen hundred and seventy-three.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

The main purpose of these Regulations is to further amend the First Schedule to the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, as amended, by raising from two pounds to five pounds the weekly earnings limit for the purpose of modifying the classification of certain insured persons in specified employments.
