The Social Insurance (Collection of Contributions) (Amendment) (Guernsey)

Regulations, 1973

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (3) of section four and section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of regulation ten and regulation eleven of the principal regulations.

1. In regulation ten and in the proviso to regulation eleven of the Social Insurance (Collection of Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, as amended, the words "forty shillings" are hereby repealed and the words "six pounds" are hereby substituted therefor.

Citation and commencement.

2. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Collection of Contributions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1973, and these regulations and the Social Insurance (Collection of Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1969, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Collection of Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 to 1973.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the *tenth* day of *September*, nineteen hundred and seventy-three.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These Regulations amend the Social Insurance (Collection of Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, by raising from two pounds to six pounds the weekly earnings limit in the case of employed persons where liability for contributions is determined by reference to their earnings.
