

IMPORT AND EXPORT CONTROL (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL)(GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1971AMENDMENT TO OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control)(Guernsey) Order, 1971, dated the 16th March, 1971 (a), the importation into Guernsey of goods consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the States Board of Administration:

NOW THEREFORE the States Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises as follows:-

1. The Open General Import Licence made by the States Board of Administration and dated the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy one, (b), is hereby amended as follows:-
 - (a) In Article 4, the word "or" at the end of paragraph (d) and the whole of paragraph (e) are deleted.
 - (b) In the First Schedule thereto the following entries (and the related letter "E") are deleted:-
 - (i) "Dead poultry and edible offals thereof, fresh, chilled or frozen".
 - (ii) "Cream, fresh, not concentrated or sweetened".
 - (iii) "Cream, preserved, concentrated or sweetened".
 - (iv) "Cheese; curd containing less than 50% by weight of butter fat (including hydrogenated butter fat and other chemically or physically modified butter fat)".
 - (v) "Lactose".
 - (vi) "Lactose, flavoured or coloured".
 - (vii) "Other watch and clock parts".
 - (c) In the First Schedule thereto in the case of the entry "milk, preserved, concentrated or sweetened containing less than 50% by weight of butter fat" for "NST" there is substituted "D".
 - (d) In the First Schedule thereto for the entry relating to sausages and the like, of pig or poultry products, there is substituted the following:-
"ESausages and the like other than salami, of pig or poultry products".
 - (e) In the First Schedule thereto for the entry relating to articles of apparel and clothing accessories, of leather or of composition leather, there is substituted the following:-
"EGloves of leather or of composition leather".
 - (f) In the First Schedule thereto for the entry relating to travelling rugs and blankets, wholly or mainly of woven cotton, of man-made fibres, of wool or of fine animal hair there is substituted the following:-
"ETravelling rugs and blankets other than electric blankets, wholly or mainly of woven cotton, of man-made fibres, of wool or of fine animal hair".

- (g) In the Second Schedule thereto for the entry relating to travelling rugs and blankets, containing more than 50% by weight of woven cotton there is substituted the following:-

"Travelling rugs and blankets, other than electric blankets, containing more than 50% by weight of woven cotton".

2. This Amendment shall take effect on the second day of February, nineteen hundred and seventy two, and may be modified or revoked at any time by the States Board of Administration.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Amendment to the Open General Import Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The main effects of this Amendment are that:-

- (a) in future, the Licence will not authorise the importation of handloom cotton textiles originating in and consigned from India;
- (b) dead poultry, cheese, salami, lactose, apparel of leather or of composition leather (other than gloves), electric blankets and certain watch and clock parts may now be imported under the Licence notwithstanding that they originate in, or are consigned from the Eastern Area;
- (c) preserved, concentrated or sweetened milk containing less than 50% by weight of butter fat may now be imported under the Licence from all sources except the Dollar Area.
