

IMPORT AND EXPORT CONTROL (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL)(GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1971AMENDMENT TO OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control)(Guernsey) Order, 1971, dated the 16th March, 1971 (a), the importation into Guernsey of goods consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the States Board of Administration:

NOW THEREFORE the States Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises as follows:-

1. The Open General Import Licence made by the States Board of Administration and dated the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy one, (b), as amended is hereby further amended as follows:-

- (a) In Article 5(i), after sub-paragraph (iii) there shall be added the following:-

" or;

- (iv) of raw, tanned or dressed furskins (other than tanned or dressed furskins assembled in plates, crosses and similar forms), or of rugs or coverlets made from furskins, except where:-

- (a) a written declaration is delivered to the proper officer of Customs containing a statement specifying the description of animals from which the furskins were obtained, and
- (b) the furskins were obtained from animals other than animals of the following descriptions:-

Clouded leopard (neofelis nebulosa)  
Snow leopard (uncia uncia)  
Leopard (panthera pardus)  
Tiger (panthera tigris)  
Cheetah (acinonyx jubatus)  
Vicuna (vicugna vicugna)."

- (b) In the First Schedule the following entry, as amended (and the related letter D) is hereby deleted:-

"Milk, preserved, concentrated or sweetened, containing less than 50% by weight of butter fat."

- (c) In the First Schedule the following entry (and the related letter W) is hereby deleted:-

"Vicuna Skin".

2. This Amendment shall take effect on the third day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy two and may be modified or revoked at any time by the States Board of Administration.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Amendment to the Open General Import Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The main effects of this Amendment are that:-

- (1) Furskins, and rugs and coverlets made from furskins, obtained from animals of the descriptions mentioned in Article 1 (a) are added to the goods which may not be imported from any source under the authority of the Licence.
  - (2) Preserved, concentrated or sweetened milk containing less than 50% by weight of butter fat may now be imported under the Licence notwithstanding it originates in, or is consigned from the Dollar Area.
