The Gambling (Public Lotteries)(No. 3)(Amendment No. 7) Order, 1972

Made 23rd May 1972

Coming into operation 23rd May 1972

THE STATES GAMBLING CONTROL COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections three, six, seven and eight of the Gambling (Public Lotteries) Ordinance, 1971 (a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby orders:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Gambling (Public Lotteries)(No. 3) Order, 1971 (b) and the Gambling (Public Lotteries)(No. 3) (Amendment No. 6) Order, 1972 (c)
 - (a) if in the ordinary lottery to be drawn on the twenty-third day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-two any serial number exceeding the number thirty-two thousand seven hundred and seventy-nine is drawn in respect of a major prize or if in the snowball lottery to be drawn on that day any number exceeding the number thirty-two thousand seven hundred and seventy-nine is drawn in respect of the series of tickets issued in the ordinary lottery to be held on the twenty-third day of May, the Presiding Officer shall -
 - (a) declare the drawing of that serial number to be null and void;
 - (b) cause the tokens removed from the first four containers to be replaced in the containers from which they were removed;
 - (c) cause another serial number to be drawn in place of that first mentioned serial number.
2. This Order may be cited as the Gambling (Public Lotteries)(No.3) (Amendment No. 7) Order, 1972 and shall come into force on the twenty-third day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-two.
