

The Gambling (Public Lotteries)(No. 3)(Amendment No. 10) Order, 1972

Made..... 6th June 1972.....

Coming into operation..... 7th June 1972.....

THE STATES GAMBLING CONTROL COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections three, six, seven and eight of the Gambling (Public Lotteries) Ordinance, 1971 (a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby orders:-

1. In its application to the ordinary lottery to be drawn on the twentieth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-two the Gambling (Public Lotteries)(No. 3) Order, 1971 (b), as amended (c) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) in subsection (3) of section five thereof -
 - (i) the words "serial number" were substituted for the words "serial numbers";
 - (ii) paragraphs (e) and (f) were omitted;
 - (b) subsection (2) of section seven thereof were omitted.
2. The First, Second and Third Schedules to the principal Order are hereby repealed and the Schedules set out in the First, Second and Third Schedules to this Order are respectively substituted therefor.
3. The Gambling (Public Lotteries)(No. 3)(Amendment No. 8) Order, 1972 (c), is hereby repealed.
4. This Order may be cited as the Gambling (Public Lotteries)(No. 3) (Amendment No. 10) Order, 1972, and shall come into force on the seventh day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-two.

PRIZES FOR ORDINARY LOTTERIES

In the ordinary lottery to be drawn on the twentieth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-two -

1. the prize to be paid in respect of a winning ticket the serial number of which is drawn shall be the prize hereinafter specified in relation to the token drawn in connection with such winning ticket, that is to say -
 - (a) one prize of four thousand pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "1";
 - (b) one prize of one thousand five hundred pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "2";
 - (c) one prize of seven hundred and fifty pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "3";
 - (d) one prize of five hundred pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "4";
 - (e) one prize of two hundred and fifty pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "5";
 - (f) one prize of one hundred pounds in relation to each of the tokens marked with the figure "100";
 - (g) one prize of fifty pounds in relation to each of the tokens marked with the figure "50";

2. the prize to be paid in respect of a winning ticket of which the last two digits of the serial number correspond to the last two digits of the serial number drawn pursuant to the provisions of subsection (3) of section five of this Order shall be five pounds."

PRIZES FOR SNOWBALL LOTTERIES

In the snowball lottery to be drawn on the eighteenth day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, the prize to be paid in respect of a winning ticket of the scheduled series or in respect of the winning ticket of the selected series, as the case may be, the serial number of which is drawn shall be the prize hereinafter specified in connection with such winning ticket that is to say -

- (a) (i) in respect of the winning tickets of the series issued in respect of the ordinary lottery drawn on the sixth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-two whose serial numbers correspond to the first two serial numbers drawn in accordance with the provisions of subsection (2) of section six of this Order, a prize of not less than fifty pounds;
 - (ii) in respect of the winning tickets of the series issued in respect of the ordinary lottery drawn on the twentieth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-two whose serial numbers correspond to the two serial numbers next so drawn, a prize of not less than fifty pounds;
 - (iii) in respect of the winning tickets of the series issued in respect of the ordinary lottery drawn on the fourth day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy-two whose serial numbers correspond to the two serial numbers next so drawn, a prize of not less than fifty pounds;
 - (iv) in respect of the winning tickets of the series issued in respect of the ordinary lottery drawn on the eighteenth day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy-two whose serial numbers correspond to the two serial numbers next so drawn, a prize of not less than fifty pounds;
- (b) in respect of the winning ticket of the selected series whose serial number is drawn in accordance with the provisions of subsection (4) of section six of this Order, a prize of not less than five thousand pounds."
