THE BOVINE SEMEN (IMPORTATION OF CHAROLLAIS SEMEN) ORDER, 1972

The States Committee for Agriculture, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section two A of the Bovine Semen and Artificial Insemination Ordinance, 1957, as amended (a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

- Importation of Charollais semen
1. The Committee hereby specifies the Charollais breed of bovines as a breed of bovines from which semen may be imported under the provisions of section two A of the Bovine Semen and Artificial Insemination Ordinance, 1957, as amended.
 2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
 3. This Order may be cited as the Bovine Semen (Importation of Charollais Semen) Order, 1972.
 4. This Order shall come into force on the first day of August, nineteen hundred and seventy-two.
