

IMPORT AND EXPORT (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1946THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1971AMENDMENT TO OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1971 dated the 16th March, 1971 (a), the importation into Guernsey of goods consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the States Board of Administration:

NOW THEREFORE the States Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises as follows:-

1. The Open General Import Licence made by the States Board of Administration and dated the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy one, (b), as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:-
  - (a) In Article 1 -
    - (i) under the heading "Areas", for the words "Scheduled Territories" and the definition thereof, there is substituted the following:-
 

"Specified Territories" means the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man, the Commonwealth of Australia, Bahrain, Bangladesh, Barbados, Botswana, the British Solomon Islands, Brunei, Cyprus, Fiji, the Gambia, Ghana, Guyana, Iceland, India (including Sikkem), the Republic of Ireland, Jamaica, Jordan, Kenya, Kuwait, Lesotho, Malawi, Malaysia, Malta, Mauritius, New Zealand, Nigeria, the Sultanate of Oman, Pakistan, Qatar, Sierra Leone, Singapore, South Africa and South West Africa, Sri Lanka, Swaziland, Tanzania, Tonga, Trinidad and Tobago, Uganda, the United Arab Emirates, Western Samoa, the People's Democratic Republic of Yemen, Zambia and any part of Her Majesty's dominions (except Canada and Southern Rhodesia) not mentioned among the foregoing."
    - (ii) under the heading "Consignment - Lourenco Marques and Beira", for the words "Scheduled Territories" there are substituted the words "Specified Territories",
  - (b) In Article 3 (vi), for the words "Scheduled Territories" there are substituted the words "Specified Territories".
2. This Amendment shall take effect on the Twenty third day of August, nineteen hundred and seventy two and may be modified or revoked at any time by the States Board of Administration.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Amendment to the Open General Import Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport.

The main effects of this Amendment are that:-

- (1) For the references to "Scheduled Territories" in Articles 1 and 3 of the Licence are substituted references to "Specified Territories" which are listed in 1(a)(i) of this Amendment.
- (2) Goods indicated by NST in the First Schedule to the Licence may not be imported under the authority of the Licence if they originate in or are consigned from a country outside the Specified Territories.
