The Gambling (Public Lotteries)(No. 3)(Amendment No. 29) Order, 1972.

Made 21st November, 1972

Coming into Operation 22nd November, 1972.

THE STATES GAMBLING CONTROL COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections five, six, seven and eight of the Gambling (Public Lotteries) Ordinance, 1971 (a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby orders:-

1. In its application to the ordinary lottery to be drawn on the nineteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-two the Gambling (Public Lotteries)(No. 3) Order, 1971 (b), as amended (c) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") shall have effect as though, in sub-section (2) of section seven thereof the words "last two digits" were substituted for the words "last three digits".
2. The First, Second and Third Schedules to the principal Order are hereby repealed and the Schedules set out in the First, Second and Third Schedules to this Order are respectively substituted therefor.
3. The Gambling (Public Lotteries)(No. 3)(Amendment No. 27) Order, 1972 (c), is hereby repealed.
4. This Order may be cited as the Gambling (Public Lotteries)(No. 3) (Amendment No. 29) Order, 1972, and shall come into force on the twenty second day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-two.

PRIZES FOR ORDINARY LOTTERIES

In the Ordinary Lottery to be drawn on the nineteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-two -

1. The prize to be paid in respect of a winning ticket the serial number of which is drawn shall be the prize hereinafter specified in relation to the token drawn in connection with such winning ticket, that is to say -
 - (a) one prize of five thousand pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "1";
 - (b) one prize of one thousand pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "2";
 - (c) one prize of five hundred pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "3";
 - (d) one prize of one hundred pounds in relation to each of the tokens marked with the figure "100";
 - (e) one prize of fifty pounds in relation to each of the tokens marked with the figure "50";
 - (f) one prize of twenty-five pounds in relation to each of the tokens marked with the figure "25";
2. (a) The prize to be paid in respect of a winning ticket of which the last three digits of the serial number correspond to the last three digits of the serial number drawn pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (c) of subsection (3) of section five of this Order shall be ten pounds.
- (b) The prize to be paid in respect of a winning ticket of which the last two digits of the serial number correspond to the last two digits of the serial number drawn pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (f) of subsection (3) of section five of this Order shall be five pounds."

PRIZES FOR SNOWBALL LOTTERIES.

In the snowball lottery to be drawn on the nineteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, the prize to be paid in respect of a winning ticket of the scheduled series or in respect of the winning ticket of the selected series, as the case may be, the serial number of which is drawn shall be the prize hereinafter specified in connection with such winning ticket that is to say -

- (a) (i) in respect of the winning tickets issued in respect of the ordinary lottery drawn on the twenty-sixth day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy-two whose serial numbers correspond to the first two serial numbers drawn in accordance with the provisions of subsection (2) of section six of this Order, a prize of not less than fifty pounds;
- (ii) in respect of the winning tickets of the series issued in respect of the ordinary lottery drawn on the twenty-fourth day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-two whose serial numbers correspond to the two serial numbers next so drawn, a prize of not less than fifty pounds;
- (iii) in respect of the winning tickets of the series issued in respect of the ordinary lottery drawn on the twenty-first day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-two whose serial numbers correspond to the two serial numbers next so drawn, a prize of not less than fifty pounds;
- (iv) in respect of the winning tickets of the series issued in respect of the ordinary lottery drawn on the nineteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-two whose serial numbers correspond to the two serial numbers next so drawn, a prize of not less than fifty pounds;
- (b) in respect of the winning ticket of the selected series whose serial number is drawn in accordance with the provisions of subsection (4) of section six of this Order, a prize of not less than four thousand pounds."
