

The Import Duties (Developing Countries)(Bailiwick of Guernsey)(Amendment) Order, 1972

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by section two and section ten of the Import Duties Act (Bailiwick of Guernsey) 1932, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. The Import Duties (Developing Countries)(Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 1971(a) is hereby amended as follows:-
 - (a) In Article 2 for the words "1st January 1973" there shall be substituted the words "1st January 1974";
 - (b) in the first Schedule -
 - (i) in Part I, the following entries shall be inserted at the appropriate places in alphabetical order in the list of independent states:-

The People's Republic of Bangladesh
The Kingdom of Bhutan
The Republic of Cuba
The Sultanate of Oman
Sikkim;
 - (2) in Part I, the following entries shall be inserted at the appropriate places in alphabetical order in the list of dependent territories, associated states and states whose external relations are conducted by third countries:-

Comoro Islands
French Territory of the Afars and Issas;
 - (3) in Part II, after the entry relating to the Kingdom of Afghanistan, there shall be inserted the following entry:-

The Kingdom of Bhutan		Calcutta;

 - (4) in Part II, after the entry relating to the Republic of Rwanda, there shall be inserted the following entry:-

Sikkim		Calcutta.

 - (1) This Order may be cited as The Import Duties (Developing Countries) (Bailiwick of Guernsey)(Amendment) Order, 1972.
 - (2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.
 - (3) In this Order the expression "the principal Laws" means the Import Duties (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Laws, 1932 to 1960.
 - (4) This Order shall come into operation in the Islands of Guernsey and Alderney on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-three, and in the Island of Sark so soon thereafter as the provisions of the principal Laws with reference to the putting into operation therein of this Order shall have been complied with.
