The Aliens

(Revocation of Employment Restrictions) Order, 1972

Made . . . . . 27th December, 1972

Coming into Operation . . . . . 1st January, 1973.

---

The States Board of Administration, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 5(3) of the Aliens Restriction (Guernsey) Law, 1958, hereby orders:

1. This Order may be cited as the Aliens (Revocation of Employment Restrictions) Order, 1972 and shall come into operation on 1st January, 1973.
2. (1) Any employment restriction which applies to an alien who is a national of a state which is a member of the European Economic Community is hereby revoked.  
(2) In this Article "employment restriction" means -
  - (a) any landing condition imposed under section 5 of the Aliens Restriction (Guernsey) Law, 1958, or
  - (b) any restriction imposed by virtue of paragraph 4 of the First Schedule to the said Law which prohibits an alien from or imposes restrictions on taking employment or engaging in any occupation in the Bailiwick.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order revokes any restrictions on taking employment or engaging in any occupation in the Bailiwick imposed on an alien under the Aliens Restriction (Guernsey) Law, 1958, and still in force on 1st January, 1973, if the alien is a national of a state which is a member of the European Economic Community.
