

GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

The Social Insurance (Overlapping Benefits) (Amendment)  
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1971

Made 7th June, 1971  
Coming into Operation 7th June, 1971

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section thirty-eight and section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment to regulation two of the principal regulations.

1. In the proviso to paragraph (2) of regulation two of the Social Insurance (Overlapping Benefits) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") immediately after the words "sickness benefit" there shall be inserted a comma and the words ", maternity benefit".

Repeal of regulation six of the principal regulations.

2. Regulation six of the principal regulations is hereby repealed and the following regulation is hereby substituted therefor:-

"Construction of Part II

6. Nothing in this Part of these regulations shall be construed as requiring either -

- (a) that any personal benefit under the Law by way of industrial medical benefit, limited medical benefit, maternity grant, death grant or travelling allowance grant shall be adjusted; or
- (b) that any personal benefit or dependency benefit shall be adjusted by reason of personal benefit under the Law by way of industrial medical benefit, limited medical benefit, maternity grant, death grant or travelling allowance grant."

Repeal of Schedule to the principal regulations.

3. The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Citation and Commencement.

4.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Overlapping Benefits) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, and these regulations and the Social Insurance (Overlapping Benefits) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1968, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Overlapping Benefits) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 to 1971.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the seventh day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

SCHEDULE Regulation 3.

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Showing in Column 1, by paragraphs, personal benefits under the Law which are not required to be adjusted by reference to any personal benefit shown in the corresponding paragraph of Column 2.

Column 1	Column 2
(1) Widow's basic pension or widow's preserved pension.	(1) Unemployment benefit, sickness benefit or maternity allowance.
(2) Any personal benefit.	(2) Industrial disablement benefit.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations amend the Social Insurance (Overlapping Benefits) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1968, so as to take account of the introduction of maternity benefit, death grant and travelling allowance grant as benefits under the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended.
