

GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

The Post Office (British Commonwealth and Foreign Post)  
(Amendment) Order, 1971

Made ..... 5th February, 1971.

Coming into operation ..... 15th February, 1971.

THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections sixteen, nineteen and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended (a), hereby orders:-

Amendments to section eighteen of Order of 1969.

1. In section eighteen of the Post Office (British Commonwealth and Foreign Post) Order, 1969 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") (b) the words "one penny", "two shillings" and "four pence" are hereby repealed and the words "one new penny" and "ten new pence" and the figures and letter "1.5p" are hereby respectively substituted therefor.

Amendment to section nineteen of Order of 1969.

2. In paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section nineteen of the principal Order the words "three shillings" are hereby repealed and the words "fifteen new pence" are hereby substituted therefor.

Amendment to section twenty of Order of 1969.

3. In subsections (a) and (b) of section twenty of the principal Order the words "three pounds and eight shillings" are hereby repealed and the symbol and figures "£3.40" are hereby substituted therefor.

Amendments to section twenty-six of Order of 1969.

4. Section twenty-six of the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:-

- (a) in subsection (1) thereof the words "nine pence" and "one shilling" are repealed and the words "four new pence" and "five new pence" are respectively substituted therefor;
- (b) in subsection (2) thereof the words "three pence" are repealed and the words "one new penny" are substituted therefor;
- (c) in subsection (3) thereof the words "one shilling" are repealed and the words "five new pence" are substituted therefor.

New Schedule to Order of 1969.

5. The Second Schedule to the principal Order is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Order is hereby substituted therefor.

**Citation** 6. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (British Commonwealth and Foreign Post) (Amendment) Order, 1971.

**Commencement.** 7. This Order shall come into force on the fifteenth day of February, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.
