

GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

1971 - No. 5

The Post Office (Inland Post) (Amendment) Order, 1971.

Made ..... 5th February 1971

Coming into operation ..... 15th February, 1971

THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections fourteen, sixteen, eighteen, twenty-eight and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended

(a), hereby orders:-

Repeal of s.7.  
and s.8. of the  
Order of 1969.

1. Sections seven and eight of the Post Office (Inland Post) Order, 1969 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order")

(b) are hereby repealed.

Amendment to s.9.  
of the Order of  
1969.

2. In section nine of the principal Order the words "five shillings" are hereby repealed and the words "one pound" are hereby substituted therefor.

Amendments to s.10  
of the Order of  
1969.

3. Section ten of the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:

(a) the heading thereof is repealed and the words "Conditions as to newspapers (including current registered newspapers)" are substituted therefor:-

(b) in subsections (1), (2), (3) and (4) thereof the words "current registered" where those words occur are repealed;

(c) paragraphs (c) and (d) of subsection (4) thereof are repealed and the following paragraphs are substituted therefor:-

"(c) the title of the newspaper;

(d) in the case of a current registered newspaper, a reference to its registration for transmission by post; and

(e) a reference to any page of or place in the newspaper to which the attention of the addressee is directed."

4. Section fourteen of the principal Order is hereby repealed and the following section is hereby substituted therefor:-

(a) XIV of 1969; Ordinance No. XXX of 1969

(b) S.I. No. 24 of 1969.

- " 14(1) Subject to the provisions of this Order, any letter or parcel may be registered;
- (2) There shall be charged and paid for the registration of any letter the minimum registration fee, or, if the sender so elects, one of the higher registration fees specified in the first column of Part I of the Second Schedule to this Order;
- (3) There shall be charged and paid for the registration of any parcel the minimum registration fee, or, if the sender so elects, one of the higher registration fees specified in the first column of Part II of the Second Schedule to this Order."

5. In section fifteen of the principal Order the word and the figure "Part II" are hereby repealed and the word and the figure "Part III" are hereby substituted therefor.

Amendments to

6. Subsection (3) of section seventeen of the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:-

- (a) the words and brackets "(as stipulated in Part I or Part II of the Second Schedule to this Order)" are inserted immediately after the words "charged with the minimum registration fee";
- (b) the words "the fee of nine pence paid thereon" are repealed and the words "the fee of four new pence paid thereon" are substituted therefor.

7. Subsection (1) of section eighteen of the principal Order is hereby repealed and the following subsection is hereby substituted therefor:-

"(1) The maximum amount which shall be available for compensating persons aggrieved by the loss of or damage to a registered letter or parcel (including a letter or parcel which has been registered compulsorily under the provisions of section seventeen of this Order) and its contents shall be, in the case of letters, the amount specified in the second column of Part I of the Second Schedule to this Order or in the case of parcels, the amount specified in the second column

of Part II of the Second Schedule to this Order, opposite to the amount of the registration fee paid or charged in respect of the packet."

Amendment to s.20 of the Order of 1969.

8. In section twenty of the principal Order the words "four pounds" are hereby repealed and the words "five pounds" are hereby substituted therefor.

Amendment to s.21 of the Order of 1969.

9. In paragraph (d) of section twenty-one of the principal Order the words "printed packet" are hereby repealed.

Amendment to s.24 of the Order of 1969.

10. In subsection (1) of section twenty-four of the principal Order the words "a fee according to the scale of fees" are hereby repealed and the words "the fee" are hereby substituted therefor.

Amendments to s.32 of the Order of 1969.

11. Subsection (1) of section thirty-two of the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:-

- (a) in the definition of the expression "business reply packet" the words "or printed packet" and the words "or printed packets" are repealed;
- (b) in the definition of the expression "cash on delivery packet" the words "printed packet" are repealed;
- (c) in the definition of the expression "current registered newspaper" the words "in item 3 of the First Schedule to this Order" are repealed and the words "in item 2 of the Sixth Schedule to the Ordinance" are substituted therefor;
- (d) in the definition of the expression "first class letter" the words "the First Schedule to this Order" are repealed and the words "the Sixth Schedule to the Ordinance" are substituted therefor;
- (e) in the definition of the expression "letter" the words "except where that expression is used in section seven of this Order means any postal packet except a printed packet" are repealed and the words "means any postal packet except " are hereby substituted therefor and the words "current registered" are hereby repealed;
- (f) in the definition of the expression "the minimum registration fee" the words "or Part II" shall be inserted immediately

after the words "in the first column of Part I";

(g) the definition of the expression "printed packet" is hereby repealed;

(h) the definition of the expression "second class letter" is repealed and the following definition is substituted therefor:-

"Second class letter" means any letter posted at a place outside the Bailiwick as a second class letter within the meaning of the law of the place where it is posted;"

Amendment to s.34 of the Order of 1969.

12. In section fifteen of the principal Order as substituted by paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section thirty-four of the principal Order for the purposes of the application of the provisions of this Order to postal packets transmitted to and from the Republic of Ireland, the word and figure "Part II" are hereby repealed and the word and figure "Part III" are hereby substituted therefor.

Further amendment to s.34. of the Order of 1969.

13. In section eighteen of the principal Order as substituted by paragraph (d) of subsection (2) of section thirty-four of the principal Order for the purposes of the application of the provisions of this Order to postal packets transmitted to and from the Republic of Ireland, the words and figure "or Part II" shall be inserted immediately after the words and figure "in the first column of Part I".

Amendment to 1st and 4th Schedules to the Order of 1969.

14. In the First Schedule and in the Fourth Schedule to the principal Order items 2 and 3 are hereby repealed and the following item is hereby substituted therefor -

2. Newspaper / as for item 1(b) / Not exceeding 1lb. 8oz."

Amendments to 2nd Schedule to the Order of 1969.

15. The Second Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:-

(a) Part I thereof is repealed and the Parts set out in the First Schedule to this Order are substituted therefor;

(b) Part II thereof is re-numbered as "Part III".

New 3rd Schedule to the Order of 1969

16. The Third Schedule to the principal Order is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Second Schedule to this Order is hereby substituted therefor.

Citation.

17. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Inland Post) (Amendment) Order, 1971.

Commencement.

18. This Order shall come into force on the fifteenth day of February, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.
