

AMENDMENT TO OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE

S.I. 1971 No. 6

WHEREAS by the Import and Export of Goods (Control)(Guernsey) Order, 1955, dated the 14th June, 1955 (a) the importation into Guernsey of goods consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man is prohibited unless under the authority of a licence granted by or on behalf of the States Board of Administration:

NOW THEREFORE, the States Board of Administration, in exercise of its powers under Article 2 of the above-mentioned Order, hereby authorises as follows:-

1. The Open General Import Licence made by the States Board of Administration and dated the twenty-first day of February, nineteen hundred and sixty seven, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:-
 - (a) The following entries shall be included in Schedule 1 to the said Licence, namely:-

S....."Vicuna skin";

S....."Vicuna hair, not carded or combed";

S....."Vicuna hair, carded or combed"; and

no entry in Schedule 2 thereto shall be construed, so far as it describes the goods which may be imported under the Licence, as relating to Vicuna skin or Vicuna hair.
 - (b) In Schedule 1 thereof there shall be deleted the following entries:-
 - (i) Coal, coke and solid fuels manufactured from coal or coke;
 - (ii) S..... Coal, coke and solid fuels manufactured from coal or coke originating in or consigned from the Republic of Ireland;
 - (c) In Group 2 of Schedule 2 thereof after the entry relating to "Clay" there shall be added the following entry:-

"Coal, coke and solid fuels manufactured from coal or coke".
2. This Amendment shall take effect on the ninth day of February, nineteen hundred and seventy-one and may be modified or revoked at any time by the States Board of Administration.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Amendment to the Open General Import Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The main effect of this Amendment is that -

- (1) Individual import licences are now required for the import of Vicuna skin and Vicuna hair from all sources.
- (2) Individual import licences are no longer required for coal from any source other than Southern Rhodesia.
