

THE ROAD TRAFFIC (PROHIBITED AND ONE-WAY STREETS)

(NO. 1) REGULATIONS, 1971

Made the 17th day of February, 1971.

Coming into operation on the 22nd day of February, 1971.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine (a) and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950 (b) and of all powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island:-

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer, drive or ride that vehicle or cause or permit that animal to proceed on or along:-

- (a) La Hougue du Valle Road, Vale, otherwise than from South to North;
- (b) the unnamed road to the North of the plantation at North Side, Vale, from its junction with Bridge Road to its junction with North Quay, otherwise than from West to East and North to South;
- (c) Commercial Road, Saint Sampson, otherwise than from South to North and West to East.

2.(1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings respectively assigned to them:-

"animal" and "vehicle" have the meanings assigned to them by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine;

"Chief Officer" means the Chief Officer of the Island Police Force.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires any reference in these Regulations to any other enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including these Regulations.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets)(No. 1) Regulations, 1971.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the twenty-second day of February, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, and shall continue in force until the twenty-first day of August, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note forms no part of the Regulations but it is intended to indicate their general purport).

The effect of these Regulations is that for a period of six months from the twenty-second day of February, nineteen hundred and seventy-one:-

- (a) La Hougue du Valle Road, Vale, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed from South to North, i.e. upwards:
- (b) the unnamed road to the North of the plantation at North Side, Vale, from its junction with Bridge Road to its junction with North Quay, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed from West to East and then North to South (the road being L-shaped);
- (c) Commercial Road, Saint Sampson, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed from South to North and then West to East (the road being L-shaped).
