The Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit)
(Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971.

Made7th June, 1971

Coming into Operation7th June, 1971

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections eleven to fourteen, section twenty-two, section twenty-three and section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment to regulation two of the principal regulations.

1. Paragraph (1) of the definition of the expression "relevant period" in regulation two of the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") is hereby repealed and the following paragraph is hereby substituted therefor -

"(1) if, in respect of the relevant contribution year, there had been paid by or credited to the claimant not less than thirty-nine contributions of the appropriate class, every contribution as an insured person which is not a contribution of the appropriate class and has been paid by or credited to the claimant in respect of the relevant contribution year shall, for the purpose of his right to benefit claimed for the day in question, be treated as equivalent to a contribution of the appropriate class, save that a contribution paid in pursuance of subsection ten of the Law (which relates to widows who are employed persons) and of any regulations made under any of the provisions of section sixty-five of the Law (which relates to married women) shall not be so treated;

Insertion of new regulation 8A of the principal regulations.

2. Immediately after regulation eight of the principal regulations there is hereby inserted the following new heading and regulation numbered eight A -

"Reckoning of periods of interruption of employment.

8A. For the purpose of reckoning periods of interruption of employment, but for that purpose only, any day in respect of which a woman is

entitled to and is in receipt of maternity allowance shall (notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (c) of regulation seven of these regulations) be treated as a day of incapacity for work."

Amendments to regulation eleven of the principal regulations.

3. Regulation eleven of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows -
- (a) item (ii) of sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (2) thereof is hereby repealed; and
 - (b) in sub-paragraph (d) of paragraph (2) thereof the words "paragraph (6) of regulation seven or paragraph (2) of regulation eight of the Social Insurance (Residence and Persons Abroad) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964," are hereby repealed and the words "paragraph (2) of regulation seven of the Social Insurance (Residence and Persons Abroad) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 to 1971," are hereby substituted therefor".

Amendments to regulation thirteen of the principal regulations.

4. In regulation thirteen of the principal regulations, the words "a retirement pension" and "the retirement pension" are hereby repealed and the words "an old age pension" and "the old age pension" are hereby respectively substituted therefor.

Citation and commencement.

5. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, and these regulations and the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1966, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 to 1971.
- (2) These regulations shall come into operation on the seventh day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations amend the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1966; the provisions are consequential upon the amendments to the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964 by the Social Insurance (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1971.
