

GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

The Social Insurance (Hospital In-Patients) (Amendment)
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1971.

Made 7th June, 1971

Coming into Operation 7th June, 1971

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections thirty-eight and seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment to regulation two of the principal regulations.

1. In paragraph (2) of regulation two of the Social Insurance (Hospital In-Patients) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1969 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") the words "retirement pension" are hereby repealed and the words "old age pension" are hereby substituted therefor.

Amendments to regulation four of the principal regulations.

2.(1) In sub-paragraph (b) of regulation four of the principal regulations, the following comma and words are hereby repealed -

" , if any earnings of that dependant were disregarded otherwise than for the purpose of ascertaining whether or not the beneficiary is or has been wholly or mainly maintaining that dependant"

(2) Sub-paragraph (c) of regulation four of the principal regulations is hereby repealed and the following sub-paragraph is hereby substituted therefor -

" (c) an increase of benefit would, subject as aforesaid, be payable to the beneficiary in respect of his wife for any period in respect of which an old age pension is payable to her, if she had not attained pensionable age." .

Citation and commencement.

3.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Hospital In-Patients) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, and these regulations and the principal regulations may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Hospital In-Patients) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1969 and 1971.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the seventh day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations amend the Social Insurance (Hospital In-Patients) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1969 so as to take account of the substitution of old age pensions for retirement pensions under the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended.
