The Social Insurance (New Entrants) (Transitional)  
(Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971.

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections seventy-six and seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment to regulation two of the principal regulations.

1. Regulation two of the Social Insurance (New Entrants) (Transitional) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") is hereby amended as follows:-

(a) in paragraph (2) thereof -

- (i) the words "a retirement pension" are hereby repealed and the words "an old age pension" are hereby substituted therefor,
- (ii) the words "and to have retired from regular employment" are hereby repealed,
- (iii) the proviso is hereby repealed and the following proviso is hereby substituted therefor:-

"Provided that for the purpose of calculating the amount of the old age pension payable to a new entrant or, by virtue of his insurance, to his wife, the said yearly average shall be deemed not to exceed ten.";

(b) in paragraph (5) thereof -

- (i) in the preamble second and third lines, the words "a retirement pension" are hereby repealed and the words "an old age pension" are hereby substituted therefor,
- (ii) sub-paragraph (a) is hereby repealed,
- (iii) in sub-paragraph (b) the words "retirement pension" are hereby repealed and the words "old age pension" are hereby substituted therefor,

(iv) in sub-paragraph (c) of that paragraph, the words "retirement pensions" are hereby repealed and the words "old age pensions" are hereby substituted therefor.

Amendment to regulation four of the principal regulations.

2. In regulation four of the principal regulations, immediately after the word "benefit" there shall be inserted the words "other than death grant".

Citation and commencement,

3.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (New Entrants) (Transitional) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, and these regulations and the principal regulations may be cited together as the Social Insurance (New Entrants) (Transitional) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1971.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the seventh day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations amend the Social Insurance (New Entrants) (Transitional) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, to take account of the substitution of old age pensions for retirement pensions and the introduction of death grant as a benefit under the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended.
