THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section seventy-two, section seventy-five and section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendments to the principal regulations

1. In paragraph (1) of regulation five and in regulation six of the Social Insurance (General Transitional) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") the words "a retirement pension" wherever they occur are hereby repealed and the words "an old age pension" are hereby substituted therefor.

Citation and commencement

2.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (General Transitional) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, and these regulations and the Social Insurance (General Transitional) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1968, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (General Transitional) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 to 1971.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the seventh day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

Regulation one of these Regulations amends regulations five and six of the Social Insurance (General Transitional) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1968, so as to take account of the substitution of old age pensions for retirement pensions under the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended.
