The Social Insurance (Determination of Claims and Questions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971.

Made 7th June, 1971

Coming into Operation 7th June, 1971

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections forty-nine, fifty-two, fifty-six, seventy-two and seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders -

Amendments to regulation two of the principal regulations.

1. Paragraph (1) of regulation two of the Social Insurance (Determination of Claims and Questions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") is hereby amended as follows -

(a) immediately after the words "unemployment benefit" in sub-paragraph

(a) thereof there are hereby inserted the words "and maternity allowance",

(b) in sub-paragraph (c) thereof -

(i) immediately after the words "widow's benefit" there are hereby inserted the words "child's special allowance";

(ii) the words "a retirement pension" are hereby repealed and the words "an old age pension" are hereby substituted therefor.

Citation and commencement.

2. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Determination of Claims and Questions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, and these regulations and the principal regulations may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Determination of Claims and Questions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1971.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the seventh day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations amend the Social Insurance (Determination of Claims and Questions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 so as to take account of the substitution of old age pensions for retirement pensions and the introduction of maternity allowance and child's special allowance as benefits under the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended.
