

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL)(GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1971

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control)(Guernsey) Law, 1946, hereby orders:-

1. Subject to the provisions of this Order, all goods are prohibited to be imported into the Island or to be exported from the Island, or shipped as ships' stores.
2. Nothing in section one of this Order shall be taken to prohibit the importation or exportation of any goods or the shipment of any goods as ships' stores for use on board the ship, under the authority of a licence granted by the Board of Administration or some other person or body of persons duly authorised by the said Board to grant such licences, provided that all conditions attaching to the licence are complied with.
3. Any licence granted by the Board of Administration or other authorised licensing authority for the importation into, or the exportation from, the Island of any goods, or for the shipment of any goods as ships' stores for use on board the ship, may be modified or revoked at any time by the said Board or other authority.
4. Nothing in section one of this Order shall be taken to prohibit the importation of any goods, other than goods of a description set out in the First Schedule to this Order, which are proved to the satisfaction of the Board of Administration to have been consigned from the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man.
5. Nothing in section one of this Order shall be taken to prohibit the exportation of any goods, other than goods of a description set out in the Second Schedule to this Order, to the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man.
6. Nothing in section one or in section five of this Order shall be taken to prohibit:-
 - (a) the importation into the Island of gifts not being arms and ammunition, plumage, dangerous drugs or other articles or goods which are subject to special prohibition or restriction by virtue of legislation enacted for the purpose of controlling the importation of the said articles or goods, from a place other than a place in the United Kingdom, the Isle of Man, the Island of Jersey, or any of the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or subject to the following conditions:-
 - (i) they shall be bona fide unsolicited gifts and they shall not be imported as merchandise or for sale or for commercial or professional use;
 - (ii) they shall be clearly marked as gifts; and
 - (iii) the gross weight thereof shall not exceed twenty-two pounds avoirdupois whether the gifts are sent by post or otherwise; or
 - (b) the exportation from the Island as part of the personal baggage of a passenger of a quantity, not exceeding two hundred and fifty grammes of tobacco or tobacco products;

- (c) the exportation from the Island to a place other than a place in the United Kingdom, the Isle of Man, the Island of Jersey, or any of the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey as part of the personal baggage of a passenger of a quantity, not exceeding one bottle of wines (.75 litre) and one bottle of spirits (.75 litre);
 - (d) the exportation from the Island of personal or household effects, whether accompanied or unaccompanied, which are the personal or household effects of the exporter save that a customs officer of the States of Guernsey may, before export, require the exporter of such effects to satisfy that officer that the effects to be exported are the personal or household effects of that exporter.
7. No goods shall be unshipped, landed or put on shore except at the Harbour of Saint Peter Port, the Harbour of Saint Sampson or at La Villiaze Airport and no goods shall be shipped, put off, or waterborne to be shipped, for exportation, except from such Harbours or such Airport.
8. For the purposes of the First Schedule to this Order, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-
- (a) in the entry relating to Animal and Poultry excrement:-
 - (i) "Animal" means any horse, mare, gelding, pony, foal, colt, filly, stallion, ass, donkey, mule, bull, cow, bullock, heifer, calf, steer, ox, sheep, ewe, wether, ram, lamb, pig, boar, hog, sow, goat and kid.
 - (ii) "Poultry" means domestic fowl, turkeys, geese, ducks, and guinea fowl.
 - (b) "Caravan" means any structure designed or adapted for human habitation which is capable of being moved from one place to another (whether by being towed, or by being transported on a motor vehicle or trailer) and any motor vehicle so designed or adapted, but does not include a marquee or a tent.
9. The Orders set out in the Third Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked:
- PROVIDED that any Open General Import Licence or any Open General Export Licence granted under any Order revoked by this Order and in force immediately before the commencement of this Order, shall continue in force and have effect as if it had been granted under this Order and may be modified or revoked accordingly.
10. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
11. This Order may be cited as the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1971, and shall come into force on the seventeenth day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

Section four

Animal and Poultry excrement

Animals and other mammals except horses, donkeys, pigs, sheep, goats, dogs, cats, rabbits, hamsters, and guinea pigs.

Caravans

SECOND SCHEDULE

Section five

Coins of silver alloy of the United Kingdom minted before 1947, other than coins exported in a quantity not exceeding ten in number.

Pennies and half pennies of the United Kingdom dated before 1968, but not more than 100 years old at the date of exportation, other than coins exported in a quantity not exceeding twenty-five pounds by weight.

Tobacco and Tobacco Products.
