

The Post Office (British Commonwealth and Foreign Parcel Post)
(Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1971

Made 17th June, 1971.

Coming into Operation 1st July, 1971.

THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections sixteen, eighteen, nineteen, twenty-eight and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended(a), hereby orders:-

Amendments
to Order of
1969.

1. The Post Office (British Commonwealth and Foreign Parcel Post) Order, 1969, as amended(b), is hereby further amended as follows:-

- (a) in subsection (1) of section three thereof immediately after the words "and girth of which exceeds six feet" there are inserted the words "and seven inches";
- (b) in section nine thereof -
 - (i) in subsection (1) the words "forty pounds" are repealed and the words "fifty pounds" are substituted therefor;
 - (ii) in paragraph (a) of subsection (2) the words "a fee according to the scale of fees" are repealed and the words "the fee" are substituted therefor;
 - (iii) in paragraph (a) of subsection (3) the figures and letter "1.5p" are repealed and the words "ten new pence" are substituted therefor;
- (c) in paragraph (e) of subsection (1) of section eleven thereof the words "the sum of four hundred pounds" are repealed and the words "the sum of five hundred pounds" are substituted therefor;
- (d) in paragraph (c) of the Proviso to subsection (1) of section twelve thereof the words "the sum of four hundred pounds" are repealed and the words "the sum of five hundred pounds" are substituted therefor;
- (e) in section thirteen thereof -
 - (i) in paragraph (a) of subsection (1) the words "four new pence" and "five new pence" are repealed and the

figures and letter "7.5p" and the words "ten new pen
are respectively substituted therefor;

(ii) in subsection (2) the words "five new pence" are
repealed and the words "ten new pence" are substitut
therefor;

(f) the First and Second Schedules thereto are repealed and the
Schedules set out in the First and Second Schedules to this
Order are respectively substituted therefor.

Repeal. 2. The Post Office (British Commonwealth and Foreign Parcel Post)
(Amendment) Order, 1971(c), is hereby repealed.

Citation. 3. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (British Commonwealth
and Foreign Parcel Post) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1971.

Commencement. 4. This Order shall come into force on the first day of July,
nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

Exceeding 2lb. but not exceeding 7lb. (see note below).	3.50
Exceeding 7lb. but not exceeding 11 lb.	5.50
Exceeding 11 lb. but not exceeding 22 lb.	8.20

Note:- Where the relative postal arrangement provides for a first weight step of 3 lb., the maximum compensation payable in respect of a parcel of a weight not exceeding 3 lb. is £2.
