

The Post Office (Inland Post) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1971

Made 17th June, 1971.

Coming into operation 1st July, 1971.

THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections fourteen, sixteen, eighteen, twenty-eight and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended(a), hereby orders:-

Amendments to
Order of 1969.

1. The First and Fourth Schedules to the Post Office (Inland Post) Order, 1969, as amended(b), are hereby further amended as follows:-

(a) in the entry relating to item 1(b) in column 2 in each of those Schedules, the words "Length plus twice diameter 3 feet 3 inches. Greatest dimension 2 feet 8 inches" are repealed and the words "Length plus twice diameter 3 feet 5 inches. Greatest dimension 2 feet 11 inches" are respectively substituted therefor;

(b) the entries relating to item 5 in columns 1, 2 and 3 in each of those Schedules are repealed and the following entries are respectively substituted therefor -
