The Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit)
(Amendment) (No. 2) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971.

Made 19th July, 1971

Coming into Operation 19th July, 1971

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections eleven to fourteen, section twenty-two, section twenty-three and section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendments to the regulations of 1964.

1. The Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, as amended, are hereby further amended as follows:-

- (1) paragraph (h) of regulation seven thereof is hereby repealed;
- (2) in regulation nine thereof, the word "six" is hereby repealed and the word "seven" is hereby substituted therefor.

Amendment to regulation two of the regulations of 1966.

2. Paragraph (c) of regulation two of the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1966, is hereby repealed.

Repeal.

3. In paragraph (1) of regulation five of the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, the comma immediately after the figures "1971" where those figures first occur is hereby deleted and a full-stop is hereby substituted therefor and all the words and figures after those figures to the end of that paragraph are hereby repealed.

Citation and commencement.

4. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Amendment) (No. 2) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, and these regulations, the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, and the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations 1964 and 1966, may be cited together as

the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 to 1971.

- (2) These regulations shall come into operation on the nineteenth day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

The effect of regulation 1(1) is that a person may be regarded as unemployed on any day notwithstanding that he is in receipt of a pension or allowance from a previous employment; regulation 1(2) alters a reference to a regulation. Regulation 2 is consequential upon regulation 1(1).
