The Gambling (Public Lotteries) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order, 1971

THE STATES GAMBLING CONTROL COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections three, seven and eight of the Gambling (Public Lotteries) Ordinance, 1971, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby orders:-

1. The Gambling (Public Lotteries) Order, 1971, as amended (a), is hereby further amended as follows:-

(a) the First Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the First Schedule to this Order is hereby substituted therefor:

(b) the Second Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Second Schedule to this Order is hereby substituted therefor:

(c) the Fourth Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Third Schedule to this Order is hereby substituted therefor.

2. The Gambling (Public Lotteries) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1971, is hereby repealed.

3. This Order may be cited as the Gambling (Public Lotteries) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order, 1971, and shall come into force on the ..... Twenty-eighth ..... day of ..... July ..... nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

PRIZES FOR ORDINARY LOTTERIES

1. In the ordinary lottery to be drawn on the tenth day of August, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, the prize to be paid in respect of a winning ticket the serial number of which is drawn shall be the prize hereinafter specified in relation to the token drawn in connection with such winning ticket, that is to say -
  - (a) one prize of five thousand pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "1";
  - (b) one prize of two thousand pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "2";
  - (c) one prize of one thousand pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "3";
  - (d) one prize of five hundred pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "4";
  - (e) one prize of two hundred and fifty pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "5";
  - (f) one prize of one hundred pounds in relation to each of the tokens marked with the figure "100";
  - (g) one prize of fifty pounds in relation to each of the tokens marked with the figure "50";
  
2. In the ordinary lottery to be drawn on the tenth day of August, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, the prize to be paid in respect of a winning ticket of which the last three digits of the serial number correspond to the last three digits of either of the serial numbers drawn pursuant to the provisions of subsection (3) of section five of this Order shall be twenty-five pounds."

PRIZES FOR SNOWBALL LOTTERIES

In the snowball lottery to be drawn on the tenth day of August, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, the prize to be paid in respect of a winning ticket of the selected series the serial number of which is drawn shall be the prize hereinafter specified in connection with such winning ticket, that is to say -

- (a) in respect of the winning ticket the serial number of which is first drawn, a prize of ten thousand pounds:
- (b) in respect of each of the six winning tickets the serial numbers of which are next drawn, a prize of two hundred pounds."
