The Gambling (Public Lotteries)(Amendment)(No. 5) Order, 1971

Made18th August, 1971.....

Coming into operation19th August, 1971.....

THE STATES GAMBLING CONTROL COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections three, seven and eight of the Gambling (Public Lotteries) Ordinance, 1971, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby orders:-

1. the First, Second, Third and Fourth Schedules to the Gambling (Public Lotteries) Order, 1971, as amended, (a), are hereby repealed and the Schedules set out in the First, Second, Third and Fourth Schedules to this Order are respectively substituted therefor.
2. The Gambling (Public Lotteries) (Amendment) (No. 4) Order, 1971, is hereby repealed.
3. This Order may be cited as the Gambling (Public Lotteries) (Amendment)(No. 5) Order, 1971, and shall come into force on theNineteenth..... day of ..August....., nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

PRIZES FOR ORDINARY LOTTERIES

1. In the ordinary lottery to be drawn on the twenty-fourth day of August, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, the prize to be paid in respect of a winning ticket the serial number of which is drawn shall be the prize hereinafter specified in relation to the token drawn in connection with such winning ticket, that is to say -
 - (a) one prize of five thousand pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "1";
 - (b) one prize of one thousand five hundred pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "2";
 - (c) one prize of seven hundred and fifty pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "3";
 - (d) one prize of five hundred pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "4";
 - (e) one prize of two hundred and fifty pounds in relation to the token marked with the figure "5";
 - (f) one prize of one hundred pounds in relation to each of the tokens marked with the figure "100";
 - (g) one prize of fifty pounds in relation to each of the tokens marked with the figure "50";

2. In the ordinary lottery to be drawn on the twenty-fourth day of August, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, the prize to be paid in respect of a winning ticket of which the last three digits of the serial number correspond to the last three digits of either of the serial numbers drawn pursuant to the provisions of subsection (3) of section five of this Order shall be twenty-five pounds."

TOKENS FOR SNOWBALL LOTTERIES

Column 1 Date of Draw	Column 2 Tokens indicating series from which winning tickets shall be drawn to be placed in fifth container
26th October, 1971	<p>6 green tokens representing the series of tickets issued in respect of the ordinary lottery to be drawn on the 24th August, 1971.</p> <p>6 yellow tokens representing the series of tickets issued in respect of the ordinary lottery to be drawn on the 7th September, 1971.</p> <p>6 blue tokens representing the series of tickets issued in respect of the ordinary lottery to be drawn on the 28th September, 1971.</p> <p>6 pink tokens representing the series of tickets issued in respect of the ordinary lottery to be drawn on the 26th October, 1971.</p>

PRIZES FOR SNOWBALL LOTTERIES

In the snowball lottery to be drawn on the twenty-sixth day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, the prize to be paid in respect of a winning ticket of the selected series the serial number of which is drawn shall be the prize hereinafter specified in connection with such winning ticket, that is to say -

- (a) in respect of the winning ticket the serial number of which is first drawn, a prize of not less than seven thousand five hundred pounds:
- (b) in respect of each of the six winning tickets the serial numbers of which are next drawn, a prize of not less than seventy-five pounds."
