THE STATES ADVISORY AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section nine of the Decimal Currency (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1970, hereby orders:-

Amendments to Regulations of 1971.

1. Regulations six and seven of, and the Second Schedule to, the Family Allowances, Social Insurance and Non-Contributory Pensions (Decimalisation of the Currency) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, are hereby repealed.

Citation and commencement.

2.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Family Allowances, Social Insurance and Non-Contributory Pensions (Decimalisation of the Currency) (Amendment) (No. 2) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the sixth day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These regulations amend the Family Allowances, Social Insurance and Non-Contributory Pensions (Decimalisation of the Currency) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971 and are consequential upon amendments to the subordinate legislation made under the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Laws, 1964 to 1971.
