THE SOCIAL INSURANCE (CLAIMS AND PAYMENTS) (AMENDMENT)
(GUERNSEY) REGULATIONS, 1971.

Made..... 16th December, 1971

Coming into Operation.....20th December, 1971.

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section forty-four and section seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, as amended, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment to Part I of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations.

1. (1) Sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph 2 of Part I of the Second Schedule to the Social Insurance (Claims and Payments) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") is hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding the repeal of sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph 2 of Part I of the Second Schedule to the principal regulations under the foregoing provisions of this regulation, the provisions of that sub-paragraph shall continue to have effect in relation to a claim for sickness benefit made by a woman who has been confined in respect of any day which is deemed to be a day of incapacity for work by virtue of the provisions of paragraph (2) of regulation one of the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Amendment) (No. 3) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, in all respects as if these regulations had not been made.

Citation and commencement.

2. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Claims and Payments) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the twentieth day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

Consequentially upon the repeal of paragraph (2) of regulation three of the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, by the Social Insurance (Unemployment and Sickness Benefit) (Amendment) (No. 3) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, these Regulations repeal, with certain savings, the provisions of Part I of the Second Schedule to the Social Insurance (Claims and Payments) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1971, which relate to the prescribed time for the making of a claim for sickness benefit by a woman who has been confined and who is a woman to whom the said paragraph (2) applies.
