The Gambling (Public Lotteries)(No.2)(Amendment No.2) Order, 1971

Made 21st December, 1971

Coming into operation 21st December, 1971

THE STATES GAMBLING CONTROL COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections three, six, seven and eight of the Gambling (Public Lotteries) Ordinance, 1971 (a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby orders:-

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Gambling (Public Lotteries)(No.2) Order, 1971 (b) and the Gambling (Public Lotteries)(No.2)(Amendment No.1) Order, 1971 (c) -
 - (a) if in the ordinary lottery to be drawn on the twenty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, any serial number exceeding the number forty-one thousand three hundred and twenty-nine is drawn in respect of a major prize, the Presiding Officer shall -
 - (i) declare the drawing of such serial number to be null and void;
 - (ii) cause the tokens removed from the first four containers in the process of drawing such serial number to be replaced in the containers from which they were removed;
 - (iii) cause another serial number to be drawn in place of the first mentioned serial number;
 - (b) in the ordinary lottery to be drawn on the twenty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, no prize shall be paid in respect of any ticket of which the serial number exceeds the number forty-one thousand three hundred and twenty-nine
2. This Order may be cited as the Gambling (Public Lotteries) (No.2)(Amendment No.2) Order, 1971, and shall come into force on the twenty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.
