

The Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1970

Made 12th February, 1970
Laid before the States
Coming into operation 16th February, 1970

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections seven and seventy-seven of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendments to Regulations of 1964

1. Regulation twenty of the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964, as amended, is hereby amended as follows:-
 - (a) immediately after paragraph (4) thereof, there is inserted the following additional paragraph:-
 "(5) Any sum ordered to be paid to the Guernsey Insurance Fund under this regulation shall be recoverable as a penalty.";
 - (b) paragraphs (5), (6) and (7) thereof are renumbered as paragraphs (6), (7) and (8) respectively.

Citation and commencement

2. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1970, and ~~these regulations and the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 and 1968, may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1964 to 1970.~~
- (2) These regulations shall come into operation on the sixteenth day of February, nineteen hundred and seventy.
