THE ROAD TRAFFIC (PROHIBITED AND ONE-WAY STREETS)(No.4)
REGULATIONS. 1970.

Made the 10th day of March, 1970.

Coming into operation on the 16th day of March, 1970.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Traffic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine (a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950(b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations, in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island:-

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer of Police, drive or ride that vehicle, or cause or permit that animal to proceed on or along Rue Saint Germain, Castel, from its junction with La Hougue Lane to its junction with Rue de la Masse, otherwise than from West to East.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the expressions "animal" and "vehicle" have the meanings respectively assigned to them by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Traffic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty nine.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in these Regulations to any other enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment, including these Regulations.

3. The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets)(No.9) Regulations, 1969(c) are hereby repealed.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets)(No.4) Regulations, 1970.

5. These Regulations shall come into force on the sixteenth day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy and shall continue in force until the thirty-first day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This Note forms no part of the Regulations but it is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations, which repeal and replace the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets)(No.9) Regulations, 1969, provide that from 16th March, 1970 until 31st May, 1970, Rue Saint Germain, Castel, from its junction with La Hougue Lane, instead of with Queritez Road, to its junction with Rue de la Masse, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed in an easterly direction only. By the repeal of the said Regulations, Ruelle de la Pompe, Saint Martin's ceases to be a one-way street.
