THE EXPORT OF TOMATOES (PACKING AND GRADING) ORDER, 1970

The States Committee for Horticulture, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (3) of section two of the Export of Tomatoes (Packing and Grading) Ordinance, 1961 (a), as amended (b), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. On and before the first day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy, a person shall not deliver tomatoes to the Guernsey Tomato Marketing Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") for export otherwise than in containers designed to contain six pounds of tomatoes.
2. During the period commencing on the sixth day of April nineteen hundred and seventy and ending on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy, both dates inclusive, a person shall not deliver tomatoes to the Board for export otherwise than in containers designed to contain twelve pounds of tomatoes.
3. On and after the first day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, a person shall not deliver tomatoes to the Board for export otherwise than in containers designed to contain six pounds of tomatoes.
4. The Export of Tomatoes (Packing and Grading) Order, 1969 (c), is hereby repealed.
5. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not part of the Order
but is intended to indicate its
general purport).

This Order prescribes the sizes of containers to be used for the delivery of tomatoes to the Guernsey Tomato Marketing Board for export, as follows:-

Up to and including the 1st April, 1970 - six pound containers only.

During the period from
the 6th April, 1970
to the 31st December, 1970
both dates inclusive - twelve pound containers only.

On and from the 1st
January, 1971 - six pound containers only.

Note: On the 3rd and 4th April, 1970, to enable packers to clear
their stocks of six pound containers, tomatoes will be accepted
in either size of container.
